COURT ORDER  
(Doc. 10.)**

**ORDER FOR CLERK TO CLOSE CASE**

21 Daniel J. Rivas (“Plaintiff”) is a state prisoner proceeding *pro se* with this civil rights  
22 action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate  
23 Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

24 On April 28, 2022, findings and recommendations were entered, recommending that  
25 this action be dismissed, without prejudice, for Plaintiff’s failure to obey a court order. (Doc.  
26 12.) Plaintiff was granted fourteen days in which to file objections to the findings and  
27 recommendations. (*Id.*) The fourteen-day time period has passed, and Plaintiff has not filed  
28 objections or otherwise responded to the findings and recommendations.

1 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, this  
2 court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file,  
3 the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper  
4 analysis.

5 Accordingly, THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 6 1. The findings and recommendations issued by the Magistrate Judge on April 28,  
7 2022 (Doc. 12), are adopted in full;
- 8 2. This action is dismissed, without prejudice, for Plaintiff's failure to obey a court  
9 order; and
- 10 3. The Clerk of Court is directed to close this case.

11 IT IS SO ORDERED.
