


1 Plaintiff's objections restate arguments considered and addressed in the pending findings
2 and recommendations and those objections fail to establish any flaws with the magistrate judge's
3 reasoning. In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this court has
4 conducted a *de novo* review of the case. The court finds that the recommendation is supported by
5 the record and proper analysis.¹

- 7 1. The findings and recommendations issued November 11, 2021 (Doc. No. 25) are
8 adopted; and
- 9 2. Plaintiff's motion to remand (Doc. No. 11) is denied.
