



1 “failure to file objections within the specified time may result in the waiver of rights on appeal.  
2 (*Id.*, citing *Wilkerson v. Wheeler*, 772 F.3d 834, 839 (9th Cir. 2014), *Baxter v. Sullivan*, 923 F.2d  
3 1391, 1394 (9th Cir. 1991).) No objections were filed by either party and the deadline to do so  
4 has expired.

5 Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(c), this Court performed a *de novo* review of the case.  
6 Having carefully reviewed the entire matter, the Court concludes the Findings and  
7 Recommendations are supported by the record and proper analysis. Thus, the Court **ORDERS**:

- 8 1. The Findings and Recommendations issued on April 6, 2023 (Doc. 19) are  
9 **ADOPTED** in full.
- 10 2. Plaintiff’s appeal of the administrative decision (Doc. 13) is **GRANTED**.
- 11 3. The Commissioner’s request to affirm the decision (Doc. 17) is **DENIED**.
- 12 4. The matter is **REMANDED** for further proceedings pursuant to sentence four of  
13 42 U.S.C. § 405(g).
- 14 5. The Clerk of Court is directed to enter judgment in favor of Plaintiff Lisa L.  
15 Madrid, and against Defendant Kilolo Kijakazi, Acting Commissioner of Social  
16 Security, and to close this case.
