On June 7, 2021, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations recommending the instant action be dismissed for failure to comply with a court order and failure to prosecute. (Doc. No. 13.) Those findings and recommendations were served on plaintiff and contained notice that any objections were to be filed within fourteen (14) days after service. (*Id.* at 3.) 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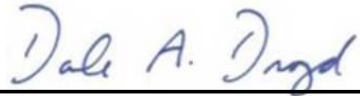
1 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, the
