The matter was 18 19 referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 20 302. 21 On July 12, 2021, the assigned magistrate judge screened plaintiff's complaint and issued 22 findings and recommendations recommending that this action be dismissed due to plaintiff's failure to state a cognizable claim upon which relief may be granted. (Doc. No. 6.) Those 23 24 pending findings and recommendations were served on plaintiff and contained notice that any 25 objections thereto were to be filed within fourteen (14) days after service. (Id. at 5.) To date, no 26 objections to the pending findings and recommendations have been filed, and the time in which to 27 do so has now passed. 28 ///// 1
