| 20 | I. RELEVANT BACKGROUND | |
| 21 | On November 14, 2023, following screening of Plaintiff's second amended complaint, the | |
| 22 | Court issued Findings and Recommendations to Dismiss this Action for Failure to State a Claim | |
| 23 | Upon Which Relief Can Be Granted. (Doc. 27.) | |
| 24 | On December 4, 2023, Plaintiff timely filed his objections. (Doc. 29.) | |
| 25 | II. DISCUSSION | |
| 26 | In its Findings and Recommendations, the Court found Plaintiff's second amended | |
| 27 | complaint failed to comply with Rule 8 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, failed to comply | |
| 28 | with the First Screening Order, should not be converted to a pro se civil action, and that | |

1 amendment was futile because it appeared Plaintiff was unable or unwilling to cure the 2 deficiencies identified in the screening order. (Doc. 27 at 5-8.) The Court recommended 3 Plaintiff's second amended complaint be dismissed without prejudice for a failure to state a claim. 4 (*Id.* at 8.) 5 In his objections, Plaintiff apologizes to the Court "for his errors in following the courts instructions." (Doc. 29 at 1.) Plaintiff includes an "amended complaint wherein plaintiff followed 6 7 the courts instructions closely" and asks the Court to consider it as he "thinks and believes he has 8 corrected" the errors identified by the Court. (*Id.*) 9 The Court will vacate the Findings and Recommendations issued November 14, 2023, and 10 direct the Clerk of the Court to file the amended complaint, filed and submitted as a part of 11 Plaintiff's objections, as Plaintiff's third amended complaint. The Court will screen Plaintiff's 12 third amended complaint as required by 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(a) in due course. III. 13 **CONCLUSION AND ORDER** 14 For the reasons given above, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that: 15 1. The Findings and Recommendations issued November 14, 2023 (Doc. 27) are VACATED; and 16 17 2. The Clerk of the Court is **DIRECTED** to file the amended complaint submitted as a 18 part of Plaintiff's December 4, 2023 (Doc. 29 at 3-59) filing separately on the docket 19 as Plaintiff's Third Amended Complaint. 20 IT IS SO ORDERED. 21 /s/ Sheila K.
