16	Plaintiffs initiated this civil rights action on July 12, 2021. (ECF No. 1). Since then, the	
17	Court has not scheduled the case in order to await rulings on various motions to dismiss. (ECF	
18	Nos. 14, 38). Moreover, following an informal discovery dispute conference, the Court stayed	
19	discovery as to Defendant Volvo Car USA, LLC. (ECF No. 54). This matter is now before the	
20	Court on the parties' joint status report, which the Court directed the parties to file to address	
21	whether this case should be scheduled in light of Defendant's most recently filed motion to	
22	dismiss. (ECF Nos. 81, 89, 90).	
23	The parties agree that a scheduling conference should not be set until Defendant Volvo's	
24	pending motion to dismiss is decided and agree to confer again on matters covered by the	
25	conference required under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(f). (ECF No. 90). However, the	
26	parties raise another issue—they dispute whether discovery should continue to be stayed, with	
27	Plaintiff wanting to commence discovery and Defendant Volvo wanting discovery to remain	
28	stayed.

1	In order to address this issue, the Court will direct the parties to contact Courtroom		
2	Deputy Felicia Navarro to set an informal discovery dispute conference.		
3	Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED as follows:		
4	1. The Court will not set a scheduling conference at this time.		
5	2. Within ten days after the issuance of the ruling on the motion to dismiss, should the matter		
6	go forward, the parties are directed to contact Courtroom Deputy Felicia Navarro		
7	( <u>fnavarro@caed.uscourts.gov</u> ) to secure a new scheduling conference date.		
8	3. Within seven days from the date of this order, the parties shall contact Courtroom Deputy		
9	Felicia Navarro ( <u>fnavarro@caed.uscourts.gov</u> ) to schedule an informal discovery dispute		
10	regarding the issue of whether discovery should remain stayed.		
11	IT IS SO ORDERED.
