



1 at his new address were returned as “Undeliverable, Attempted-Not Known, Unable to Forward.”  
2 Plaintiff has not responded to the findings and recommendations, filed a new notice of change of  
3 address, or otherwise communicated with the court.

4 Therefore, on May 2, 2022, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and  
5 recommendations, recommending that this action be dismissed, without prejudice, due to  
6 plaintiff’s failure to prosecute. (Doc. No. 17.) Those findings and recommendations were again  
7 served on plaintiff and contained notice that any objections thereto were to be filed within  
8 fourteen (14) days after service. (*Id.* at 3.) No objections have been filed with the court, and the  
9 deadline to do so has now passed.

10 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(C), this court has conducted a  
11 *de novo* review of the case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the court concludes that the  
12 magistrate judge’s findings and recommendations are supported by the record and by proper  
13 analysis.

14 Accordingly,

- 15 1. The findings and recommendations issued on May 2, 2022 (Doc. No. 17) are  
16 adopted;
- 17 2. This action is dismissed, without prejudice, due to plaintiff’s failure to prosecute;  
18 and
- 19 3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to close this case.
