**ORDER DISMISSING CASE, WITHOUT
PREJUDICE, FOR PLAINTIFF'S FAILURE
TO OBEY COURT ORDER
(ECF No. 8.)**

ORDER FOR CLERK TO CLOSE CASE

21 Sammy R. Quair, Sr. ("Plaintiff") is a Kings County Jail inmate proceeding *pro se* with
22 this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States
23 Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

24 On December 17, 2021, findings and recommendations were entered, recommending that
25 this action be dismissed without prejudice for Plaintiff's failure to obey a court order. (ECF No.
26 9.) Plaintiff was granted fourteen days in which to file objections to the findings and
27 recommendations. (Id.) The fourteen-day time period has passed, and Plaintiff has not filed
28 objections or otherwise responded to the findings and recommendations.

1 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, this
2 court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the
3 court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper analysis.

4 Accordingly, THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 5 1. The findings and recommendations issued by the magistrate judge on December
6 17, 2021, are adopted in full;
- 7 2. This action is dismissed, without prejudice, for Plaintiff's failure to obey a court
8 order; and
- 9 3. The Clerk of Court is directed to close this case.
