15	this civil rights action. The matter was referred to a United States magistrate judge pursuant to 28		
16	U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Eastern District of California Local Rule 302.		
17	On December 27, 2021, the assigned magistrate judge entered findings and		
18	recommendations, recommending that "[t]his case proceed on Plaintiff's Eighth Amendment		
19	conditions of confinement claim against defendants Doe 1, Degough, and Doe 2," and that "[a]]]		
20	other claims be dismissed." Doc. No. 14 at 18. Plaintiff was provided an opportunity to file		
21	objections to the findings and recommendations. <u>Id.</u> Plaintiff filed his objections on January 5,		
22	2022. Doc. No. 15.		
23		S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a	
24	de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, including Plaintiff's		
25	objections, the Court concludes that the findings and recommendations are supported by the		
26	record and by proper analysis.

12	3.	This case is REFERRED BACK to the magistrate judge for further proceedings.
