19	Pending before the Court is the parties' Joint Motion to Extend Case Management and		
20	Scheduling Deadlines, filed on October 23, 2024. (Doc. No. 44). The Court previously granted		
21	extensions to certain case management deadlines on October 5, 2023 and May 21, 2024. (Doc.		
22	Nos. 25, 38). Due to Plaintiff's criminal prosecution, which the parties expect will conclude		
23	within six to twelve months, the parties request further extensions to the case management		
24	deadlines. (Doc. No. 44). The parties also advise that Plaintiff has agreed to submit to mental		
25	examination upon the conclusion of his criminal case, thus resolving Defendants' pending Motion		
26	to Compel (<i>Id.</i>). (<i>Id.</i> at $2 \P 5$). Finally, the parties advise that Plaintiff also will submit to a		
27	deposition upon the conclusion of his criminal matter. (Id. \P 6). Based on the foregoing, the		
28	Court finds good cause to grant an extension to certain of the deadlines in the Case Management		

1	Scheduling Order. Fed. R. Civ. P. 16(b)(4). ¹
