**ORDER ADOPTING FINDINGS AND
RECOMMENDATIONS TO DISMISS
ACTION FOR FAILURE TO PROSECUTE
AND FAILURE TO OBEY COURT ORDERS**

(Doc. 23)

Plaintiff Randy Ausborn, a pretrial detainee, is appearing *pro se* in this civil rights action brought pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

On July 7, 2022, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations to dismiss this action for Plaintiff’s failure to prosecute and failure to obey court orders. (Doc. 23.)¹ Plaintiff did not file objections and the time to do so has passed.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper analysis.
