2 The Court served the Findings and Recommendations on Plaintiff, which contained a
3 notice that any objections were due within fourteen days of the date of service. (Doc. 23 at 6.) In
4 addition, the magistrate judge advised Plaintiff that the “failure to file objections within the
5 specified time may result in waiver of his rights on appeal.” (Id., citing *Wilkerson v. Wheeler*, 772
6 F.3d 834, 839 (9th Cir. 2014); *Baxter v. Sullivan*, 923 F.2d 1391, 1394 (9th Cir. 1991). To date,
7 Plaintiff has not filed objections, and the time to do so has expired.

8 Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court conducted a de novo review of this case.
9 Having carefully reviewed the matter, the Court concludes the Findings and Recommendations to
10 be supported by the record and proper analysis. Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS**:

- 11 1. The Findings and Recommendations issued on May 1, 2023 (Doc. 23) are
12 **ADOPTED** in full.
- 13 2. Plaintiff’s motion for protection order filed March 3, 2023 (Doc. 20) is **DENIED**.
- 14 3. The matter is referred to the magistrate judge for further proceedings.
