ORDER ADOPTING FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING 13 DISMISSAL OF CERTAIN CLAIMS AND v. **DEFENDANTS** 14 PFEIFFER, et al., (ECF No. 11) 15 Defendants. 16 17 Plaintiff Jared Andrew Martin ("Plaintiff") is a county jail inmate and former state 18 prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 19 § 1983. 20 On September 19, 2022, the assigned Magistrate Judge screened Plaintiff's first amended 21 complaint and issued findings and recommendations that this action proceed against Defendant 22 Cardenas for failure to protect in violation of the Eighth Amendment. (ECF No. 11.) The Magistrate Judge further recommended that all other claims and defendants be dismissed based 23 24 on Plaintiff's failure to state claims upon which relief may be granted. (Id.) The findings and recommendations were served on Plaintiff and contained notice that any objections were to be 25 26 filed within fourteen days after service. (Id. at 15.) On September 28, 2022, Plaintiff timely filed 27 objections to the findings and recommendations. (ECF No. 12.) 28 Plaintiff's objections generally set forth his disagreement with the Magistrate Judge's 1

This action is referred back to the Magistrate Judge for proceedings consistent with SENIOR DISTRICT JUDGE
