CLAIM 12 WARDEN, et al., (Doc. 65) 13 Defendants. 14 Plaintiff William Vera, also known as Memo Vera, is a state prisoner proceeding pro se 15 16 and in forma pauperis in a civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This matter was 17 referred to a United States magistrate judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 18 302. 19 On June 10, 2024, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations to 20 dismiss this action for plaintiff's failure to state a claim upon which relief could be granted, 21 following screening of the second amended complaint. Doc. 65. Plaintiff was afforded 14 days 22 within which to file objections. *Id.* at 23-24. Thereafter, on June 25, 2024, the magistrate judge granted plaintiff's request for a 60-day extension of time within which to file objections. Doc. 68. 23 24 On July 8, 2024, plaintiff filed a notice of appeal. Doc. 69. The notice was processed to the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals and assigned case number 24-4190. Doc. 70. On August 29, 25 26 2024, the Ninth Circuit issued its order dismissing the appeal for a lack of jurisdiction. Doc. 72. 27 In accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1), this Court has conducted a de novo review of 28 this case. Having reviewed the file, the Court finds the findings and recommendations to be 1

supported by the record and proper analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The findings and recommendations issued on June 10, 2024 (Doc. 65) are ADOPTED IN FULL; 2. This action is DISMISSED without leave to amend for plaintiff's failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted; and 3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to terminate any pending motions and to close this case. IT IS SO ORDERED. Dated: November 25, 2024
