

1 approval of the minor's compromise be approved. (Doc. 31.) In addition, the magistrate judge
2 recommended the minor's net compensation be assigned as follows: (1) an annuity be purchased
3 in the amount of \$30,000.00 for the benefit of the minor, (2) \$1,000.00 be released to guardian ad
4 litem and H.G.'s mother Yubiel Magana, and (3) \$8,825.83 be placed in a blocked account where
5 it cannot be withdrawn until H.G.'s eighteenth birthday.

6 The Court served the Findings and Recommendations on all parties and notified them that
7 any objections thereto were to be filed within 14 days after service. (*Id.*) To date, neither party
8 has filed objections, and the deadline for doing so has passed. According to 28 U.S.C. § 636
9 (b)(1)(C), the Court has conducted a *de novo* review of the case. Having carefully reviewed the
10 entire file, the Court concludes that the magistrate judge's Findings and Recommendations are
11 supported by the record and proper analysis. Thus, the Court **ORDERS**:

- 12 1. The Findings and Recommendations issued on November 6, 2023, (Doc. 31), are
13 **ADOPTED** in full.
- 14 2. The petition for approval of minor's compromise (Doc. 27) is **GRANTED**.
- 15 3. An annuity **SHALL** be purchased from JMW Settlements LLC in the amount of
16 \$30,000.00 from the minor's net compensation for the benefit of the minor, which
17 will yield a total payout of \$48,000.00 over a 3-year period when the minor turns
18 19.
- 19 4. \$1,000.00 of the minor's net compensation **SHALL** be released to guardian ad
20 litem and H.G.'s mother Yubiel Magana to obtain a residence.
- 21 5. \$8,825.83 of the minor's net compensation **SHALL** be placed in a blocked
22 account at Noble Credit Union in Fresno, California where it cannot be withdrawn
23 until H.G.'s eighteenth birthday or otherwise ordered by the Court.
