

1 objections within the specified time may result in the waiver of rights on appeal. *Id.* at 3 (citing
2 *Wilkerson v. Wheeler*, 772 F.3d 834, 839 (9th Cir. 2014)).

3 According to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1), this Court has conducted a *de novo* review of this
4 case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court concludes the findings and
5 recommendations are supported by the record and by proper analysis.

6 Based upon the foregoing, the Court ORDERS:

- 7 1. The findings and recommendations issued on February 16, 2024 (Doc. 9) are adopted
8 in full.
- 9 2. This action is DISMISSED without prejudice for Petitioner’s failure to obey a court
10 order, to comply with the Local Rules, and to prosecute this action.
- 11 3. The Clerk of Court is directed to CLOSE this case.
