The Parties request that the Court vacate any upcoming 20 hearings and deadlines while the performance of the settlement terms is pending. Once all terms of the settlement are completed and payment is received by 21 Plaintiff and after payment of Plaintiff's attorneys' fees, costs and expenses, to be determined by agreement of the Parties or by noticed motion, the Parties shall file 22 an executed Stipulation of Dismissal of the entire action with prejudice. The 23 Parties expect to file the dismissal papers within 90 days. Based on the foregoing, the Parties respectfully request that the Court Order that 24 this action be dismissed without prejudice and the Court continue to retain 25 jurisdiction over this action to enforce the terms of the settlement agreement. (ECF No. 56). 26 As a notice of settlement has been filed, the Court will vacate any and all deadlines and 27 proceedings currently pending before the Court. However, rather than dismiss this action now, the 28 1

1	Court will wait to dismiss the action until after the parties file their upcoming stipulation of
2	dismissal.
3	Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED as follows:
4	1. In light of Plaintiffs' notice of settlement, any and all deadlines and proceedings currently
5	pending before the Court are vacated. (ECF No. 56).
6	2. The parties shall file their stipulation of dismissal by no later than February 10, 2025.
