| 19 | amended complaint on February 13, 2023. (ECF No. 12.) | |
| 20 | On February 17, 2023, the Court issued an order requiring Plaintiff to show cause why | |
| 21 | this action should not be dismissed for failure to exhaust administrative remedies. (ECF No. 13.) | |
| 22 | Plaintiff filed a response to the order to show cause on March 10, 2023. (ECF No. 14.) | |
| 23 | On March 10, 2023, the assigned Magistrate Judge discharged the order to show cause | |
| 24 | and issued findings and recommendations recommending that this action be dismissed, without | |
| 25 | prejudice, based on Plaintiff's failure to exhaust his administrative remedies prior to filing this | |
| 26 | action. (ECF No. 16.) Those findings and recommendations were served on Plaintiff and | |
| 27 | contained notice that any objections thereto were to be filed within fourteen (14) days after | |
