(Doc. 15.) The Court served the findings and recommendations on 18 19 the parties appearing in the action and notified them that any objections thereto were to be filed 20 within fourteen (14) days after service. (Id.) No objections have been filed, and the time in 21 which to do so has passed. 22 According to 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(c), this Court has conducted a *de novo* review of the case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds that the findings and 23 24 recommendations are supported by the record and proper analysis. Thus, the Court **ORDERS**: 1. The findings and recommendations issued on May 4, 2023 (Doc. 15) are 25 ADOPTED IN FULL. 26 2. Plaintiff's motion for default judgment (Doc. 8) is **GRANTED** with a reduction in 27 28 the requested amount of attorneys' fees.

1	3.	Default judgment shall be entered in favor of plaintiff and against defendant
2		Jasvinder Singh dba NS Transport in the amount of \$996,308.80, plus post-
3		judgment interest, less any net proceeds received from the liquidation of any
4		collateral vehicles recovered.
5	4.	Defendant is ordered to pay plaintiff an amount of \$6,725.50, which represents
6		the reasonable attorneys' fees, expenses and costs incurred in enforcing the loan
7		agreements at issue and in collection of the amounts due.
8	5.	Plaintiff is awarded final possession of the unrecovered vehicles identified in the
9		findings and recommendations and, upon recovery, is authorized to liquidate the
10		vehicles in a commercially reasonable manner.
11	6.	The Clerk of the Court is directed to close this case.
12	IT IS SO ORDERED.
