This matter was referred to a United 19 States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On May 17, 2023, the assigned Magistrate Judge issued findings and recommendation 21 recommending that the action be dismissed for failure to state a cognizable claim for relief. (ECF 22 No. 15.) The findings and recommendations were served on Plaintiff and contained notice that 23 any objections thereto were to be filed within fourteen days of service. (Id. at 5.) According to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a de novo review of this case.
