19	2023, the Court granted Respondent's superseding motion to dismiss and dismissed the petition	
20	as moot given that Petitioner had not suffered a final order of removal and Petitioner had	
21	received the remedy he requested in his petition. (ECF No. 21.) That same day, judgment was	
22	entered and the case closed. (ECF No. 22.)	
23	On February 2, 2024, the Court receive the instant motion to reopen case based on new	
24	discovery evidence. (ECF No. 23.) Therein, Petitioner alleges that he is being denied time credits	
25	based on a final administrative removal order issued on September 22, 2023.
