ORDER ON STIPULATION GRANTING

Before the Court is the parties’ Stipulation to Voluntary Remand Pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) and to Entry of Judgment. (Doc. 11). Upon consideration of the parties’ stipulation, pleadings and for good cause shown, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The above-captioned matter is remanded to the Commissioner of Social Security for further administrative proceedings pursuant to sentence four of Section 205(g) of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g);
2. Upon remand, the Appeals Council will remand the case to an Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) for a new decision in accordance with the parties’ stipulation (Doc. 11); and
