**ORDER VACATING PENDING DATES AND
REQUIRING PARTIES TO FILE
DISPOSITIONAL DOCUMENTS**

FORTY FIVE DAY DEADLINE

On October 24, 2024, a notice of settlement was filed informing the Court that the parties have reached a settlement in this action. (ECF No. 25.) The parties proffer that dispositional documents will be filed within 90 days.¹ The Court shall order that the parties file dispositional documents within forty-five days. Any additional request for extension of time to file dispositional documents must be supported by good cause.

Accordingly, it is **HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. All pending matters and dates in this action are **VACATED**; and
2. The parties shall file dispositional documents within **forty-five (45) days** of entry of this order.
