**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE DISPOSITIVE
DOCUMENTS**

JANUARY 8, 2025 DEADLINE

On October 24, 2024, a notice of settlement was filed informing the Court that the parties had reached a settlement in this action. (ECF No. 25.) The parties noted that attorney’s fees, costs, and expenses remained outstanding and if the parties could not reach an informal resolution, Plaintiffs intended to file a noticed motion. On October 24, 2024, the Court ordered that the parties file dispositional documents within forty-five days. (ECF No. 26.)

On December 2, 2024, Plaintiff filed a declaration indicating that Plaintiffs’ attorney’s fees and costs remain outstanding. (ECF No. 25.) Plaintiff requests that the Court extend the deadline to file dispositional documents by an additional sixty days from December 9, 2024, to February 7, 2025, to allow Plaintiffs to file a noticed motion for attorney’s fees. The Court finds good cause to grant Plaintiffs’ request. However, Plaintiffs do not provide the date upon which they intend to file the motion for attorney’s fees. As such, the Court shall order that Plaintiffs shall file their motion for fees and costs on or before January 8, 2025.

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Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiffs shall file their motion for fees and costs no later than **January 8, 2025**. If no motion is filed, dispositive documents shall be filed **no later than February 7, 2025**.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
