The 25 parties further request that the Court direct the Clerk of the Court to enter a final judgment in 26 favor of Plaintiff, and against Defendant, reversing the final decision of the Commissioner. 27 This stipulation constitutes a remand under the fourth sentence of Section 205(g) of the 28 Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 405(g).
