ORDER

The parties in this case have represented that this case settled. (Docket No. 29.) Pursuant to that representation, the assigned Magistrate Judge directed the parties to file dispositional documents by September 26, 2024. (Docket No. 30.) The Magistrate Judge then ordered plaintiffs to file a motion for approval of a minor's compromise by October 28, 2024, based on


1 the parties' request for additional time to finalize settlement.
2 (Docket Nos. 31, 32.) Plaintiffs did not file such motion and
3 did not appear during the Magistrate Judge's telephonic status
4 conference held on November 5, 2024. (Docket Nos. 33-35.) The
5 United States then filed a status report on November 8, 2024 in
6 which it represented that plaintiffs intended to "promptly" file
7 a motion for minor's compromise. (Docket No. 37.)

8 Notwithstanding the passage of more than two months since that
9 representation, and multiple orders from the Magistrate Judge,
10 plaintiffs still have not filed a request for approval of a
11 minor's compromise.

12 In light of the foregoing, on or before **February 10,**
13 **2025**, the parties shall file a joint status report, and counsel
14 for plaintiffs shall show cause in writing why they should not be
15 sanctioned for failure to comply with the court's orders. See
16 Local Rule 110; Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b). A status conference and
17 hearing on this order to show cause is hereby set for **February**
18 **24, 2025 at 1:30 p.m.** in Courtroom 5 of the Matsui Federal
19 Courthouse in Sacramento, California. Counsel for all parties
20 shall personally appear, and no appearances via telephone or
21 videoconference shall be permitted. Should plaintiffs file a
22 motion for approval of minor's compromise before the February 24,
23 2025 hearing, the court will hear such motion at that time.

24 IT IS SO ORDERED.
