17	Plaintiff, a former state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, has filed this		
18	civil rights action seeking relief under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United		
19	States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.		
20	On November 9, 2023, Plaintiff filed a notice of change of address with the Court. ECF		
21	No. 11. The notice indicated that Plaintiff is no longer incarcerated. <u>Id.</u> As a result, Plaintiff was		
22	ordered to file a new application to proceed in forma pauperis that is used for non-prisoners. ECF		
23	No. 12.		
24	Plaintiff has filed the application to proceed in forma pauperis for non-prisoners. ECF		
25	No. 13. He has submitted the affidavit required by 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(1) showing that he is		
26	unable to prepay fees and costs or give security for them. <u>Id.</u> Therefore, Plaintiff's new request		
27	to proceed in forma pauperis will be granted.

1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's non-prisoner application to	
2	proceed in forma pauperis (ECF No. 13) is GRANTED.
