(ECF No. 1.) The initial scheduling 18 conference is currently set for August 8, 2024. (ECF No. 3.) 19 20 On March 6, 2024, the parties filed a stipulated to extend the deadline for Defendant to respond to the complaint until March 27, 2024. (ECF No. 4.) Because this initial extension was 21 less than twenty-eight days from the deadline, no approval from the Court was necessary. See 22 L.R. 144(a). 23 On March 26, 2024, the parties filed a joint motion to extend the deadline for Defendant 24 to file a respond to the complaint to April 17, 2024. (ECF No. 6.) The parties seek Court 25 approval of this extension past twenty-eight days to allow further time for factual development 26 and settlement discussions. The Court finds good cause exists to grant the extension. 27
