17	Plaintiff Jacob Chaffin Wall filed a complaint on March 26, 2024, challenging a final	
18	decision of the Commissioner of Social Security denying an application for disability benefits.	
19	Plaintiff did not pay the filing fee in this action and instead filed an application to proceed in	
20	forma pauperis pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. (ECF No. 2.)	
21	The Court finds Plaintiff's application demonstrates entitlement to proceed without	
22	prepayment of fees. Therefore, the Court shall order that the complaint in this action be served,	
23	pursuant to paragraph 1 of the scheduling order to be issued in this action, which provides that	
24	service on the Defendant shall proceed under the Court's e-service program.
