



1 1424 (9th Cir. 1986). (*Id.* at 2-4.) The Court served these Findings and Recommendations on  
2 Plaintiff and notified him at that any objections were due within 14 days. (*Id.* at 5.) The Court  
3 advised him that the “[f]ailure to file objections within the specified time may result in the waiver  
4 of certain rights on appeal.” (*Id.*, citing *Wilkerson v. Wheeler*, 772 F.3d 834, 838-39 (9th Cir.  
5 2014).) Plaintiff did not file objections, and the time to do so expired.

6 According to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1), this Court performed a *de novo* review of this case.  
7 Having carefully reviewed the matter, the Court concludes the Findings and Recommendations  
8 are supported by the record and proper analysis. Thus, the Court **ORDERS**:

- 9 1. The Findings and Recommendations issued on October 25, 2024 (Doc. 14) are  
10 **ADOPTED** in full.
- 11 2. This action is **DISMISSED** without prejudice for Plaintiff’s failure to obey the  
12 Court’s order and failure to prosecute.
- 13 3. The Clerk of Court is directed to close this case.
