ORDER

On July 2, 2010, plaintiffs filed a motion seeking to compel payment of fees for work done by “legal support staff members that are not ‘paralegals’ as defined by California Business & Professions Code Section 6450(a).” A hearing on this motion is presently set for August 30, 2010.
