**STIPULATION AND ORDER RE: USE
 OF FORCE REPORTS FROM CSP-

21 The Parties to the above-captioned case, through their counsel, stipulate as follows:

- 22 1. On March 8, 2005, the Court ordered that: “Within thirty days from the end of
 23 each month, defendants shall provide to the special master a copy of incident reports at
 24 CSP/Corcoran involving the use of force against Mental Health Services Delivery System
 25 (MHSDS) caseload inmates, as well as a copy of said institution’s Institution Head Use of Force
 26 Review Form with a notation on the disposition for each incident reviewed during the preceding
 27 month.” (Docket No. 1654 at 3, ¶ 7.)

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ORDER

Pursuant to the stipulation of the parties, and good cause appearing, this Court hereby amends its March 8, 2005 order (Docket No. 1654) so that Defendants are no longer required to provide monthly reports and forms on use of force incidents at CSP-Corcoran. No further revisions are made to that order.
