Following filing of closing briefs by the parties, the 23 matter was submitted for decision. 2.4 25 On January 17, 2014, plaintiffs filed a request for a status 26 conference to address issues arising from the death of a member 27  $^{1}$  Approximately five of those days were spent on testimony related to

of the plaintiff class on September 7, 2013 (ECF No. 4982). Plaintiffs' request for status conference was granted by order filed January 22, 2014 (ECF No. 4992) and the matter is set for status conference on January 30, 2014.

In view of plaintiffs' request and matters raised therein, and good cause appearing, the submission of plaintiffs' May 29, 2013 motion (ECF No. 4638) is hereby VACATED pending resolution of whether, and if so how if at all, issues presented by the death of this class member bear on the use of force questions presented by plaintiffs' May 29, 2013 motion.
