17	Pursuant to court order, on June 10, 2014 the Special Master	
18	filed a Report on the San Quentin Assessment Project for	
19	Inpatient Care of Condemned Inmates (hereafter San Quentin	
20	Report). (ECF No. 5164.) Therein, the Special Master reports,	
21	<u>inter</u> alia, that thirty-seven condemned inmates "have been	
22	referred, accepted, and are awaiting admission to intermediate	
23	inpatient care", San Quentin Report (ECF No. 5164) at 9, and that	
24	defendants are developing an inpatient mental health program for	
25	condemned inmates at San Quentin State Prison, "to be known as	
26	the San Quentin Psychiatric Inpatient Program (SQ PIP)." Id. at	
27	2.

The Special Master requests an order (1) directing 1 defendants to provide monthly status reports to him on the SQ PIP 2 3 until the beginning of its' activation; and (2) requiring him to 4 report to the Court not later than ninety days following the full activation of SQ PIP on its' full activation on patient 5 б admissions, treatment, and "any other matters or concerns within 7 the SQ PIP which may have emerged as of that time." Id. at 11. Neither party has filed objections to the report or the order 8 requested by the Special Master. 9 After review of the San Quentin Report and good cause 10 11 appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 12 The CDCR defendants shall provide monthly status reports 1. 13 on the SQ PIP to the Special Master until the beginning of activation of the SQ PIP; and 14 15 2.
