24	temporarily be conducted only once per hour during First Watch (2200 hours to 0600 hours),				
25	while Defendants worked to assess and possibly reduce noise caused by the opening and closing				
26	of the Unit's pod doors. Order, Dec. 28, 2015, ECF No. 5393. That stipulation expired by its				
27	terms on May 1, 2016 but was extended by further stipulation of the parties and Order of the				
28	Court until June 30, 2016. <i>Id.</i> ; Stipulation Extending Order Modifying Security/Welfare Checks 1

5	The parties seek an additional extension of the Court's May 3, 2016 order modifying its		
6	February 3, 2015 Order allowing Defendants to temporarily conduct Security/Welfare checks		
7	utilizing Guard One at the Pelican Bay SHU once per hour during First Watch (2200 hours to		
8	0600). This extension of the stipulation modifying the Court's order will expire on August 31,		
9	2016, and may be continued by further Stipulation.
