4	5:12. On April 24, 2024, Plaintiffs requested permission to have a second class
5	representative, Peter Cockcroft, CDCR No. H86887, attend in addition to Mr. Coleman. See
6	ECF No. 8211. On April 25, 2024, the Court issued Writs of Habeas Corpus ad
7	Testificandum for Mr. Coleman and Mr. Cockcroft. ECF Nos. 8214, 8215.
8	Neither Mr. Coleman nor Mr. Cockcroft are available to attend the mediation session
9	on May 10, 2024. Plaintiffs have informed Defendants' counsel that they are withdrawing
10	their requests for both class representatives to attend.
11	Plaintiffs hereby withdraw their requests for Mr. Coleman and Mr. Cockcroft to
12	attend the May 10, 2024 mediation session and request that the Court excuse them from
13	attendance.
