(ECF No. 29.) It has now been stayed for more than 18 fourteen years. On November 4, 2014, respondent filed a motion to lift the stay and dismiss the 19 case. (ECF No. 34.) On November 21, 2014, the undersigned lifted the stay and ordered 20 petitioner's counsel, Denise Kendall, to file a response to the motion to dismiss. Petitioner's 21 counsel has filed a response, and a request that new counsel be appointed in order to respond to 22 the motion to dismiss, in light of her conflict of interest. (ECF No. 36.) In light of the 23 information provided, the Federal Defender is ordered to either accept appointment of counsel or 24 designate for appointment new counsel to represent petitioner. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that: 25 26

1. Petitioner's request to appoint new counsel is granted, (ECF No. 36), and the Federal Defender is ordered to either accept appointment as counsel for petitioner or designate for appointment new counsel to represent petitioner within **seven** days of this order;

1	2. Newly appointed counsel for petitioner shall file a response to respondent's motion to
2	dismiss within twenty-one days of this order;
3	3. The Clerk of the Court shall serve this order on Carolyn Wiggin, Assistant Federal
4	Defender; and
5	4. The Clerk of the Court shall also serve petitioner at his most recent address, at Mule
6	Creek State Prison.
