16	Petitioner has requested an extension of time to file and serve objections to the
17	findings and recommendations issued by the court in this case on August 17, 2009. The court
18	will grant petitioner's request in part. Petitioner is advised that the purpose of the objections is to
19	inform the court of "those portions of the report or specified proposed findings or
20	recommendations to which objection is made." 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(C). The purpose of such
21	objections is not to provide the parties an opportunity to conduct additional research and present
22	new arguments that were not included in the motion heard by the assigned magistrate judge.
23	Finally, a legal brief and attachments in support of the objections is not required.
24	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
25	1. Petitioner's September 3, 2009 motion for an extension of time
26	(Doc. No. 128) is granted in part;

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2. Petitioner shall file and serve his objections to the August 17, 2009 findings
and recommendations, if any, on or before September 23, 2009. No further extensions of time
will be granted for this purpose; and

3. No reply by respondent to petitioner's objections is required unless further ordered by the court.
