would have been granted absent defendants' unconstitutional conduct or whether such damages are barred by *Heck v. Humphrey*, 512 U.S. 477 (1994). The parties should include in their briefs a discussion of whether a habeas corpus remedy remains available to plaintiff and the ///// /////
