

1 **ORDER**

2 This Court, having considered the parties' Joint Stipulation to Stay The Case For 45 Days,
3 finds that good cause exists to grant the parties' request to stay the proceedings for 45 days, including
4 all discovery and dispositive motion deadlines, and to hold a further status conference, if necessary,
5 to address the case schedule after the 45-day period has passed if the parties have not concluded the
6 settlement by that date. Therefore, a status conference is scheduled to commence at 9:00 a.m. on
7 December, 14, 2009. A joint statue report shall be filed fourteen days before the status conference.
8 Further, the motion filed April 20, 2009 (Document 254) is deemed withdrawn.
