ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

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15 Petitioner is a state prisoner proceeding *in propria persona* with a petition for a writ of  
16 habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. By order dated January 26, 2005, this matter was  
17 administratively stayed to allow petitioner the opportunity to exhaust certain claims in state  
18 court. By order filed May 31, 2005, petitioner was directed to inform the court when he had  
19 exhausted his state court remedies. Petitioner has not corresponded with the court since that  
20 time. In light of the above, petitioner will be granted thirty days from the date of this order to  
21 show cause why this action should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P.  
22 41(b); L.R. 110.

23 Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that petitioner show cause, within thirty days from this  
24 order, why this action should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute.
