ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Petitioner is a state prisoner proceeding *in propria persona* with a petition for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. By order dated January 26, 2005, this matter was administratively stayed to allow petitioner the opportunity to exhaust certain claims in state court.
