12 Plaintiffs and defendants, by their respective counsel, have reported that the
13 appeals by plaintiffs to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit have
14 been dismissed. Accordingly, the trial of the above-captioned consolidated actions
15 is set for **October 5, 2010 at 9:00 a.m.** in Courtroom No. 5. The court estimates
16 that trial will last approximately ten to fifteen days.

17 The parties, by their counsel, have also stipulated that the various due dates

19 intact, but will be keyed to the trial date set by this Order. Accordingly, the various
20 pre-trial filings shall be made the number of days in advance of the trial date that
21 are specified in the Final Pre-Trial Order.
