


1 Order states "[i]f no objections are made [within 30 days], the
2 Pretrial Order will become final without further order of the
3 court." (Pretrial Order 21:21-22, ECF No. 180.) Although
4 Plaintiff filed objections to certain portions of the Pretrial
5 Order, the objections to the undisputed facts section of the
6 order are overruled and Plaintiff's remaining objections concern
7 matters that fail to prevent the Pretrial Order from becoming
8 final. Further, the Pretrial Order was supplemented by Orders
9 filed May 22, 2015 and June 1, 2015. (ECF Nos. 206 and 210.)

10 Therefore, Plaintiff's discovery requests are untimely
11 since discovery is closed and Plaintiff has not shown that the
12 date by which discovery was to have been completed should be
13 modified to prevent manifest injustice. Accordingly, Plaintiff's
14 discovery requests filed March 31, 2016 (ECF Nos. 262, 263 and
15 264) are DENIED; Plaintiff's discovery request filed April 1,
16 2016 (ECF No. 265) is DENIED; Plaintiff's discovery request filed
17 April 8, 2016 (ECF No. 266) is DENIED; Plaintiff's discovery
18 request filed April 14, 2016 (ECF No. 267) is DENIED; and
19 Plaintiff's discovery requests filed April 22, 2016 (ECF Nos.
20 268, 269, 270 and 271) are DENIED.
