DAVIS., et al., 14 Defendants. 15 On January 30, 2009, this court heard plaintiffs' motions for 16 leave to amend, to certify a class, and for a preliminary 17 18 injunction, as well as defendant's motion to strike. The court 19 granted leave to amend and class certification (Orders of Feb. 25, 20 2009, Doc. 181, and March 4, 2009, Doc. 182), denied the motion to 21 strike (Order of March 4, 2009, Doc. 183), and retained the motion 22 for a preliminary injunction under submission. Defendants then 23 filed a motion to dismiss, which was heard on May 18, 2009, and which was also taken under submission. 24 25 On May 28, 2009, the Ninth Circuit granted defendants'

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petition for permission to appeal this court's order granting class

1 certification. Doc. 192, <u>see also</u> Ninth Circuit case no. 9-80052.

The court hereby directs the parties to submit briefing not to exceed fifteen (15) pages regarding the effect of the Ninth Circuit's grant of permission on this court's jurisdiction over this case, and regarding the effect of that decision on the motions currently under submission. Such additional briefing shall be filed within fifteen court days of the date of this order.

The court further grants the parties' stipulation of August 8 9 2009, Doc. 202. 5, Service of process of the Fourth Amended/Supplemental Complaint on behalf of the Commissioners and 10 11 Deputy Commissioners in their official capacities has been completed, and responsive pleading by those defendants to the 12 13 Fourth Amended/Supplemental Complaint shall be filed on or before 20 days from the Court's ruling on defendant's motion to dismiss. 14 15 IT IS SO ORDERED.
