 20 This matter comes before the Court on the parties stipulation to lift stay.

21 In an Order dated January 3, 2007, the Court granted an Agreed Motion to Stay filed by  
 22 Intermotive and Defendant InPower, LLC ("InPower"). The Court's Order stayed the action  
 23 pending completion of the *inter partes* reexamination of the patent-in-suit. At the time, the  
 24 United States Patent and Trademark Office had granted InPower's request for *inter partes*  
 25 reexamination on the patent-in-suit. *Inter Partes* Reexamination has been completed for the  
 26 patent-in-suit.

2 After reviewing the materials submitted by the parties it appears all reexamination  
3 proceedings and any associated appeals in the United States Patent and Trademark Office  
4 (USPTO) for U. S. Letters Patent No. 6,594,565 have ended.

7 joint status report addressing the status of the litigation and a proposed schedule for future  
8 proceedings within thirty days of the date of this order.
