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1	file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by
2	proper analysis.
3	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
4	1. The findings and recommendations filed September 9, 2011, are adopted in
5	full;
6	2. Plaintiff's January 10, 2011 motion for summary judgment (Doc. No. 35) is
7	granted as set forth in the findings and recommendations;
8	3. Defendant's January 27, 2011 cross-motion for summary judgment (Doc. No.
9	36) is denied;
10	4. The decision of the Commissioner of Social Security is reversed; and
11	5. This action is remanded for further proceedings consistent with this order.
