11 Corrections and Rehabilitation, and Stephanie Clauss, Chief Deputy
12 General Counsel, at (916) 327-5306; and
- 13 4. Failure to comply with this order will be grounds for the imposition of
14 sanctions deemed appropriate by the Court.
