There is a substantial possibility that the outcome of the Martin case could alter the framework established by the Ninth Circuit for evaluating the adequacy of California's procedural bars under *Bennett v. Mueller*, 322 F.3rd 573 (9th Cir. 2003) and King v. Lamarque, 464 F.3d 963 (9th Cir. 2006). Dckt. No. 61. The parties stipulated that briefing on respondent's pending motion for summary judgment, which is based on procedural defaults, be suspended until further order of the court. The court finds that this action should be administratively stayed pending the issuance of a decision in Martin. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. Briefing on the pending motion for summary judgment is stayed pending the issuance of a decision in Martin; and 2.
